



## **MARCEGAGLIA: THE 2,000TH LIEBHERR CRANE DELIVERED IN RAVENNA**

*It's the second-largest model by the German manufacturer and a state-of-the-art machine in terms of comfort and safety*

*Ravenna, July 8, 2025* - The official handover ceremony for the new Liebherr LHM 600 mobile harbor crane took place today at the Marcegaglia Ravenna plant. The crane, which arrived at the Mantua-based steel group's site last May, is the second-largest model in Liebherr's portfolio and a benchmark in technological innovation, comfort, and safety. With a reach of 61 meters and a lifting capacity of 154 tons, it ranks among the most powerful harbor cranes operating in the Port of Ravenna.

With this latest addition – the sixth crane supplied by Liebherr over the years – Marcegaglia Ravenna now operates a fleet of five cranes dedicated to quay operations and the loading and unloading of steel coils. This delivery also marks a historic milestone: the crane installed in Ravenna is the 2,000th mobile harbor crane ever produced by the German group. The occasion was celebrated with an official ceremony at the Ravenna facility, attended by the senior management – and founding families – of both companies: Antonio Marcegaglia, Chairman and CEO of Marcegaglia Steel, who co-leads the family business with his sister Emma; Patricia Rűf, third-generation member of the Liebherr family and board member of Liebherr-International AG; and Leopold Berthold, Managing Director of Liebherr-MCCtec GmbH.

"I wanted to be here in Ravenna personally today," **stated Patricia Rűf, third-generation member of the Liebherr family and board member of Liebherr-International AG** "to underline the strength of the partnership that binds us to Marcegaglia – a fellow family-owned company with whom we've enjoyed a successful collaboration for over twenty years. We are proud that this latest crane, the 2,000th in our series and a flagship product in our portfolio, has found a home at such a cutting-edge facility as Marcegaglia Ravenna."
